

Using Warrington Libraries Catalogue App

If you have an iPhone, iPod Touch or iPad, you can download a free app called Bookmyne from the AppleStore.


With Bookmyne you can find your nearest Warrington library, search the Library catalogue using keywords or a barcode (so if you're in a bookshop you can scan the barcode to see if the library have a copy), login to your library account to renew and reserve items or check your account.

Getting Started

When you first open the application, the GPS (Global Positioning System) will establish the location of the iPhone and identify any Warrington Libraries that are within a specified distance.




Use the slider to increase the range for identifying nearby libraries.

Click on the star button  at the right to add the library to a personal list of libraries, which make it faster to gain access to your library account.

Click on the **globe button** at the top to show all the libraries in the world that are participating in this service.


Zoom in to a specific area by using the iPhone Zoom feature.


The  button at the top of the view will display your personalised list of libraries.



Select a library will show details about a library such as its location, phone number, opening hours and the web address.

You can also add the library to your personal list from here by clicking the **"Add to my libraries"** button.

The  compass button at the top will take you back to the GPS search screen.

The magnifying glass button  lets you enter a specific library to search for.



Searching the Catalogue

To search click the search button at the bottom of the screen.



Choose between searching for a keyword or a barcode; the iPhone camera can be used to scan a barcode.

Clicking on the icon to the right of a title will take you to a page providing more information about the item.

You can place holds on one or more titles directly from the search results list

Placing a reservation

This can be done from either the results of a search or the detailed item screen.

From the list select the item using the radio buttons on the left.

This will then enable the options button  in the top right hand corner of the screen.

The options are:

- Email the item as a recommendation to a friend.
- Place a hold (if you are not already logged in to your account you will be asked to enter your library card number and PIN).
- Save to My list.

When placing a hold, a list of pickup locations appropriate for their login will display.

Pressing **“Confirm”** places the hold.

Managing your account

Select the **‘My Account’** tab at the bottom of the screen to see summary information about your account.



To see more detail click the chevron (>) on the right for each section.

The **“Checked out items”** option, lists everything you currently have on loan. You can select and renew items.

The **“Holds”** option, lists your current reservations. You can select and cancel them if you wish.

“Fines and Fees” shows a summary of the total outstanding charges on your card.

“My lists” shows the list of booklists that you have created.

Scroll further down the screen to see:

“Personal Info” shows the current information held about you on our systems, such as name, address, telephone and email address.



Useful tools

Lists

After searching for items in the catalogue you can create a list and save the items to the list for future reference e.g. you can save a list of books for your holiday.

From this list you can then place reservations.

Search history

After performing a search in the Bookmyne it remembers the terms you have entered. Clicking on the terms will perform the search again. You can edit the history of your searches and delete old terms.
