All libraries in Warrington have computers you can use for **FREE**.

- Internet access (filtered)
- Set up or use your web-based email address
- MS Office and Publisher
- A4 printing available in black and white or colour (small charge)
- PCs have screen magnification software, adaptive hardware is available - just ask library staff
- Save your work or download

You can just drop in or telephone to book a computer in advance.

Please bring your library card with you to access a computer

Not a library member?

Joining is simple and free. Guest access is available for occasional use.

For children under 16...

A parent or guardian must sign to authorise their child's computer use. Parents or guardians are responsible for their child's use of the Internet.

Don't forget that you will need your library card number (and sometimes your PIN) to take full advantage of these new services.

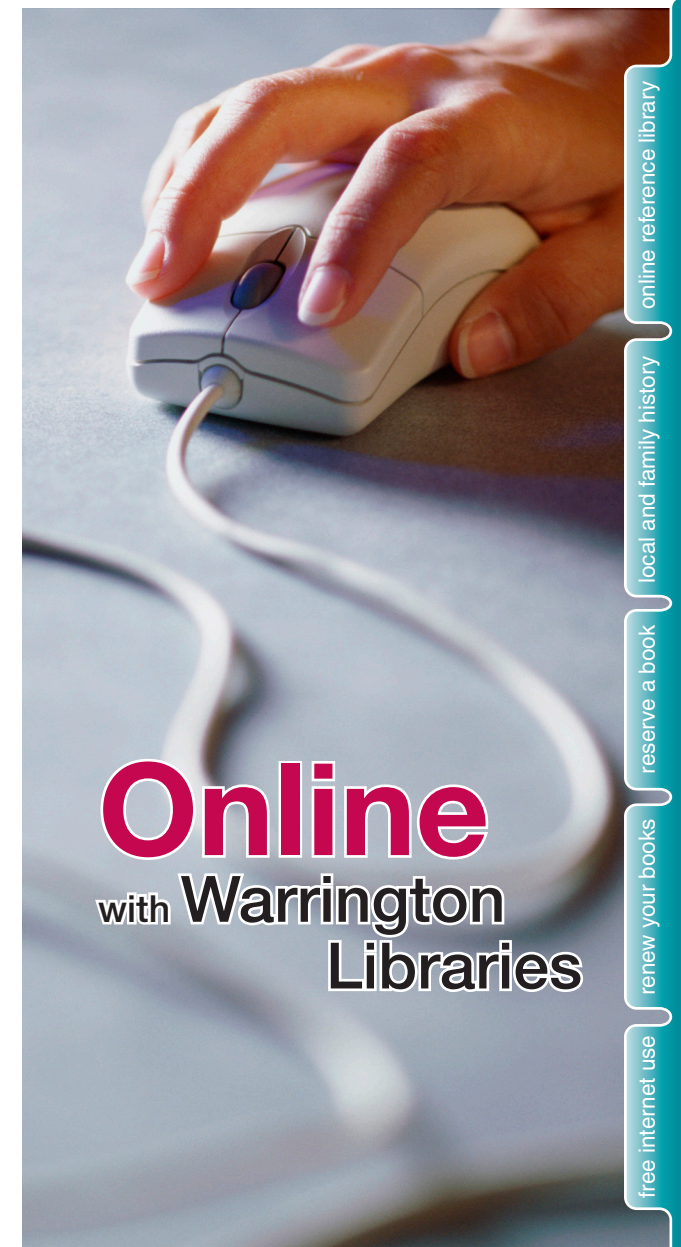
Your library card number starts with 24143 and can be found on the back of your card under the barcode.
