ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE BOROUGH OF WARRINGTON (VARIOUS STREETS) (VARIOUS RESTRICTIONS)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2010

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, in not less than 7 days from the date of this Notice, the Council intends to make an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers. The effect of which will be as follows:

PHASE 1

Temporary Prohibition of Driving

Liverpool Road From its junction with Milner Street to its junction with Crosfield Street.

Phase 1 of the works will be operative from 10:00pm on Saturday 3rd July 2010 until 6:00am on Sunday 4th July 2010 and from 10:00pm on Sunday 4th July 2010 until 6:00am on Monday 5th July 2010.

The alternative route for this phase will be via Crosfield Street, A57 Froghall Lane, A57 Priestley Street and vice versa.

PHASE 2

Temporary One Way, 3 Tonne Weight Limit & 20mph Speed Limit Restriction

Liverpool Road No vehicle shall proceed along Liverpool Road between its junctions with Milner Street and Crosfield Street except in a westerly direction. Vehicles within the restricted area must not exceed 3 Tonnes (laden or unladen) and must not exceed a speed limit of 20mph.

Phase 2 of the works will be operative from Wednesday 7th July 2010 until Friday 9th July 2010.

The alternative route for vehicles travelling eastbound for this phase will be via A57 Priestley Street, A57 Froghall Lane, A57 Midland Way, Legh Street, Sankey Street, Bold Street, A5061 Wilson Patten Street.

The alternative route for vehicles travelling westbound which exceed 3 Tonnes will be via Crosfield Street, A57 Froghall Lane, A57 Priestley Street.

PHASE 3

Temporary Prohibition of Driving

Liverpool Road From its junction with Milner Street to its junction with Crosfield Street.

Temporary One Way

Froghall Lane No vehicle shall proceed along Froghall Lane between its junctions with Bewsey Road and Midland Way except in a north easterly direction.

Phase 3 of the works will be operative from 7:00pm on Friday 9th July 2010 until 6:00am on Monday 12th July 2010.

The alternative routes for this phase are as follows:

Liverpool Road For vehicles travelling westbound will be via Crosfield Street, A57 Froghall Lane, A57 Priestley Street.

Liverpool Road For vehicles travelling eastbound will be via A57 Priestley Street, A57 Froghall Lane, A57 Midland Way, Legh Street, Sankey Street, Bold Street, A5061 Wilson Patten Street.

Froghall Lane For vehicles travelling in a south westerly direction will be via Winwick Street, Pinnars Brow, A49 Lythgoes Lane, A57 Midland Way.

PHASE 4

Temporary One Way, 3 Tonne Weight Limit & 20mph Speed Limit Restriction

Liverpool Road No vehicle shall proceed along Liverpool Road between its junctions with Milner Street and Crosfield Street except in a westerly direction. Vehicles within the restricted area must not exceed 3 Tonnes (laden or unladen) and must not exceed a speed limit of 20mph.

Phase 4 of the works will be operative from Monday 12th July 2010 until Saturday 31st July 2010.

The alternative route for vehicles travelling eastbound for this phase will be via A57 Priestley Street, A57 Froghall Lane, A57 Midland Way, Legh Street, Sankey Street, Bold Street, A5061 Wilson Patten Street.

The alternative route for vehicles travelling westbound which exceed 3 Tonnes will be via Crosfield Street, A57 Froghall Lane, A57 Priestley Street.

PHASE 5

Temporary Prohibition of Driving

Liverpool Road From its junction with Milner Street to its junction with Crosfield Street.

Phase 5 of the works will be operative from 10:00pm on Saturday 31st July 2010 until 6:00am on Sunday 1st August 2010.

The alternative route for phase 5 of the works will be via Crosfield Street, A57 Froghall Lane, A57 Priestley Street and vice versa.

ADDITIONAL MEASURES

Temporary Prohibition of Right Turn

Edelsten Street	To prohibit any vehicle proceeding on Edelsten Street from making a right hand turn into Priestley Street.
Milner Street	To prohibit any vehicle proceeding on Milner Street from making a right hand turn into Priestley Street.
Guardian Street	To prohibit any vehicle proceeding on Guardian Street from making a right hand turn into Priestley Street.
Priestley Street	To prohibit any vehicle proceeding in a north easterly direction on Priestley Street from making a right hand turn into Edelsten Street or Milner Street.
Priestley Street	To prohibit any vehicle proceeding in a south westerly direction on Priestley Street from making a right hand turn into Guardian Street.

Temporary Footway Closure

Liverpool Road (North Footway)	From its junction with Milner Street to its junction with Crosfield Street.

The alternative routes for the additional measures are as follows:

Edelsten Street	will be via A57 Priestley Street, Sankey Green Roundabout and A57 Priestley Street.
Milner Street	will be via A57 Priestley Street, Sankey Green Roundabout and A57 Priestley Street.
Guardian Street	will be via A57 Priestley Street, A57 Froghall Lane, A57 Midland Way, Cockhedge Roundabout, A57 Midland Way, A57 Froghall Lane and A57 Priestley Street.
Priestley Street (Northeast Bound)	will be via A57 Priestley Street, A57 Froghall Lane, A57 Midland Way, Cockhedge Roundabout, A57 Midland Way, A57 Froghall Lane and A57 Priestley Street.
Priestley Street (Southwest Bound)	will be via A57 Priestley Street, Sankey Green Roundabout and A57 Priestley Street.
Liverpool Road (North Footway)	will be via the southern footway

The Order will be effective from Tuesday 22nd June 2010 for a period of 9 weeks. The works are to be undertaken in phases as detailed above to ensure any disruption is kept to a minimum. Adverse weather may result in a delay to the phases of the works therefore the restrictions will be extended without further notice, however the restrictions will be in force as and when the relevant traffic signs are displayed on site.

The alternative route for HGV vehicles throughout the duration of the temporary restrictions detailed above will be via A57 Priestley Street, A57 Froghall Lane, A57 Midland Way, A49 Brick Street, A49 Fennel Street, A49 Mersey Street and vice versa.

The reason for the temporary restrictions is to allow Network Rail to carry out reconstruction works to the bridge.
