Guidance notes:

The full council tax bill assumes that there are 2 adults residing in a dwelling. However for Council tax purposes certain people will not be counted when looking at the number of adults. The effect of disregarding certain adults may be to reduce the Council Tax bill by 25% or 50 %

A person under the age of 20 who has left school, college or full time education on or after the 1st of May in any year after undertaking a qualifying course of education (for example: one no higher than A-level or equivalent) is disregarded for the purpose of working out a discount during the period 1st May to 31st October in the same year. School and college leavers continue to be disregarded if they go on to some other form of higher education.

To award a discount we require you to bring or send a photocopy of the letter from the HM Revenue and Customs, which confirms whom you are receiving child benefit for. The discount will cease on the day that Child Benefit ceases to be paid. This will normally be whatever is the earlier of:

a) One of the following dates (after full time non advanced education or approved training ceases).

Monday following; last day in February 31 May 31 August 30 November or;

b) reaching age 20, where their full time non advanced education or training commenced prior to their 19th birthday.

However, if a person is under 20 between 1st May and 1st November, and immediately prior to 30th April was undertaking a qualifying course of education, then a discount will continue to apply until 1 November.
