Local Authorities (Referendums) (Petitions and Directions) (England) Regulations 2011

Notice is hereby given that:

1. Steven Broomhead, Electoral Registration Officer and Proper Officer of the Council for the purposes of the above regulations, has published the number that is equal to 5 per cent of the number of local government electors shown on the electoral register having effect for the authority's area on 15 February 2019;
2. The number for the said purpose is **8103** ;
3. The number will be used for the purposes of determining the validity of petitions presented after 31 March 2019 and before 1 April 2020, seeking a referendum on whether or not there should be an elected mayor or alternative constitutional model, unless the circumstances mentioned in paragraph 4. below apply.
4. If the number for 2020, to be published in February 2020, is less than 8103, that lower number will be used for the purpose of determining the validity of petitions presented between the date the number is published and 31 March 2020.
5. The number that will be used for the purposes of determining the validity of petitions presented before 31 March 2019 is **8126**.
