

## Estimated costs for domestic crossing

To assist you in making a decision to submit an application form the authority has set rates for the construction of Domestic Dropped Crossings that can be installed by its Highway Term Maintenance Contractor.

To calculate the **estimated** cost of your crossing, measure the distance from the front of your property to the kerb edge and insert this measurement at (D) to the calculation the square metres.

$3.75 \times D = \text{Square Metres}$

Then use the table this to estimate the cost of your crossing

Area In Sq metres	Estimated Cost
7	£800
10	£1100
15	£1500

If you decide to apply for permission to install a crossing and approval is given, the authority will provide you with an accurate quotation for the work required. The cost of this work must be paid for in full, the authority no longer sanction monthly installments.

## ADDITIONAL COSTS TO BE CONSIDERED

Below are possible additional site specific costs which you may need to consider:	
Re-locating Street lighting column (up to 3 meters)	£1200*
Relocating internally illuminated sign (up to 3 meters)	£1000*
Removal and replacement of tree (any tree needing removal will be replaced by 2 new ones at suitable locations).	£600*
Modification of Telecommunication cover (any chamber in a footway will require a heavy duty cover & frame fitted by the Company it belongs to)	£1200*
Re-locating unlit road sign	£350*

Therefore applicants should be aware actual costs may be significantly different from above dependent on the individual circumstances and therefore should obtain firm quotations where necessary from utility companies, local authority and contractors.</p>
