

**Decision Notice
Licensing Sub-Committee

Temporary Event Notice**

To consider a temporary event notice served by **Mr Stuart John Quinnett** in respect of premises known as **53 Degrees North/Rain, 83-85 Bridge Street, Warrington.**

The Panel have considered carefully all of the written and verbal representations submitted by and on behalf of the applicant and Cheshire Constabulary.

Having regard to the Objection Notice as submitted by Cheshire Constabulary, the Licensing Sub-Committee panel have resolved:

Not to issue a Counter Notice under section 105(2) of "the Act" as members of the panel did not consider it appropriate to do so for the promotion of the Licensing Objective; Crime and Disorder for the following reasons:

The panel concluded after listening to the evidence that the applicant had demonstrated that the historic operation of the premises evidenced that allowing the temporary event would not add to the crime and disorder already being experienced in respect of the premises currently operating within the town centre.

However, the panel determined under section 106 of the Act and with the agreement of the applicant, to impose all of the conditions which ordinarily apply to the premises licence, which are not inconsistent with the application.
