During the 14-day representation period, the Council received a Notice of Objection from:

On the 10 January 2008 at 14.00 hours a hearing was held to consider the application. The Sub-Committee determined the application with a view to the promotion of Crime and Disorder. In reaching its determination the Sub-Committee had regard to the following matters:

- (1) the relevant parts of the written and oral evidence before them;
- (2) the relevant parts of the Licensing Authority's Statement of Licensing Policy 2005-2008; and
- (3) the relevant parts of the Guidance issued under Section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003 by the Secretary of State for Culture, Media and Sport.
- (4) the Human Rights Act implications in Article 8 and Article 1 of the First Protocol. These are not absolute rights but qualified ones and consideration was given to the proportionality principal.

The Sub-Committee has determined to grant the transfer application.
