Grant of an application for transfer of a Premises Licence Licensing Act 2003, Sections 44 & 45

On the 22 April 2009, Warrington Borough Council (“the Council”), being the relevant Licensing Authority, received an application to transfer a Premises Licence from you, on behalf of Raycheel Indra Nath, in respect of premises known as:

During the 14-day representation period, the Council received a Notice of objection from:

Chief Superintendant for Cheshire Constabulary dated 24 April 2009.

On 3 June 2009 at 9.30 am a hearing was held to consider the application. The Sub-Committee determined the application with a view to the promoting the four licensing objectives.

In reaching its determination the Committee had regard to the following matters:

- (1) the relevant parts of the written and oral evidence before them;
- (2) the relevant parts of the Licensing Authority’s Statement of Licensing Policy 2008-2011;
- (3) the relevant parts of the Guidance issued under Section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003 by the Secretary of State for Culture, Media and Sport; and
- (4) The Human Rights Act implications in Article 8 and Article 1 of the First Protocol. These are not absolute rights but qualified ones and consideration was given to the proportionality principal.

The Sub-Committee has determined to grant the transfer application.
