

**Decision Notice
Licensing Sub-Committee
Wednesday 25th March 2015
Temporary Event Notice**

To consider a temporary event notice served by **Mr Louis Veitch** in respect of premises known as **Bridges, Bridge Street, Warrington**.

Members of the Licensing Sub-Committee have considered carefully all of the written and verbal representations submitted by and on behalf of the applicant and Cheshire Constabulary.

Having regard to the Objection Notice as submitted by Cheshire Constabulary, members of the Licensing Sub-Committee have resolved:

Not to issue a Counter Notice under Section 105(2) of the Act as members of the panel did not consider it appropriate to do so for the promotion of the licensing objective; Crime and Disorder. However, members determined that under Section 106 of the Act and with the agreement of the applicant, to impose all of the conditions which ordinarily apply to the premises licence which are not inconsistent with the application.

Members concluded, after listening to all of the evidence and taking into account the fact that this premises had never had cause to be brought before the licensing sub-committee that the premises appeared to be well run. In view of this and the further undertakings offered up in support of the application members determined that allowing the temporary event would not impact on the licensing objective of Crime and Disorder.

For the sake of clarity the undertakings as agreed, are as follows:

1. The premises are to be closed at 2 a.m. and invited guests to return after the premises are closed via the back entrance.
2. Ticket only event (sales to stop 24 hours before event).
3. Locked door policy.
4. Premises to be vacated 30 minutes after the event but no later than 30 minutes from when the Temporary Event Notice terminates.
5. Maximum capacity for the event to be no more than 150.
