Temporary Event Notice**

To consider a temporary event notice served by **Mr Simon Pugsley** in respect of premises known as **Friars Court/The Apartment, Barbauld Street, Warrington.**

The Licensing Sub-Committee has considered carefully all of the written and verbal representations submitted by and on behalf of the applicant and Cheshire Constabulary.

The Committee is aware of its obligations under the Licensing Act 2003 and in particular the guidance issued under Section 182 of the Act together with the Council's statement of licensing policy.

Having regard to the Objection Notice as submitted by Cheshire Constabulary, members of the Licensing Sub-Committee have resolved:

**Not to issue a Counter Notice** under Section 105(2) of the Act as members of the panel did not consider it appropriate to do so for the promotion of the Licensing objective of the prevention of Crime and Disorder.

Members were satisfied that the applicant's evidence demonstrated that the historic operation of the premises evidenced that allowing the Temporary Event would not add to the cumulative impact already being experienced in respect of the premises operating in Warrington town centre. It was noted that Cheshire Constabulary accepted that the premises were well run, that they did not have problems with the venue and that there was nothing they would bring to the sub-committees attention in respect of the previous operation of the particular premises.

Members asked the applicant to ensure that the CCTV system was checked and was in good working order before the event goes ahead.
