

Licensing Act 2003: Minor Variation of the premises licence

Notice is hereby given that Punch Taverns Limited has applied in respect of the Rams Head Church Lane Grappenhall Warrington WA4 3EP for the grant of a minor variation of the premises licence under the Licensing Act 2003 to permit the following:

This is an application to vary the layout and design of the premises in accordance with the submitted plan (drawing no 1925-502), which shows internal reconfiguration to reflect an improved link between bar and dining areas, with new screens and fixed seating. The pond has also been removed and external seating area refurbished.

Any part of the variation application that changes the plan/layout at the premises to be of no effect until the work has been completed.

Locations of fire safety and other safety equipment subject to change in accordance with the requirements of the responsible authorities or following a risk assessment.

Any detail shown on the plan that is not required by the licensing plans regulations is indicative only and subject to change at any time. To remove the condition “Children shall not be allowed in the bar area”.

To permit the premises to open to the public at 08:00h every day for non-licensable activity.

The operating times and licensable activities authorised by the existing Premises Licence to remain unaltered.

Representations to this application must be made in writing, by the end of 24th July 2019, to the Warrington Borough Council Licensing Authority at New Town House, Buttermarket Street, Warrington WA1 2NH where the register of licensing applications can be inspected between during office hours.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with this application. Persons will be liable on summary conviction to an unlimited fine.
