

**Decision Notice
Licensing Sub-Committee
Friday 24th June 2016
Temporary Event Notice**

The Sub-Committee has met today to consider Temporary Event Notices served by **Mr Ali Ermis** in respect of premises known as **Star Kebab House, 41 Winwick Street, Warrington.**

The Panel considered the Temporary Event Notices for the dates and times listed below for **The Star Kebab House, Winwick Street, Warrington**, the written objection from Cheshire Police and the representations made at the hearing and took them into consideration.

- 25-26th June Midnight to 3am
- 2- 3rd July Midnight to 3am
- 9-10th July Midnight to 3am
- 16-17th July Midnight to 3am

The Panel also considered the Licensing Act 2003, regulations made thereunder, the guidance issued by the Secretary of State, Warrington Borough Council's Statement of Licensing Policy and the Licensing Objectives, in particular the Prevention of Crime and Disorder.

The Panel was of the view that the Temporary Events would not undermine the Licensing Objectives, especially if the conditions of the Premises License were applied, as offered by the Premises.

The Panel determined that there was evidence from the objector relating to the hours of the Temporary Events and a number of incidents directly relating to the premises in question. Nevertheless, on balance it was considered that on these occasions it would not be necessary for the promotion of the Licensing Objective of the Prevention of Crime and Disorder to issue a Counter Notice.

In making that decision the Sub-Committee has taken cognisance of the Police's agreement and given weight to their expert opinion.

The Panel, therefore, declined to issue a Counter Notice and the Temporary Events may proceed subject to the conditions of the Premises License.

Under Section 106A of the Act members determined to impose all of the conditions which ordinarily apply to the premises licence which are not inconsistent with the application.

21 day right of appeal notified to all parties.
