Temporary Event Notice

To consider a temporary event notice served by **Mr David Whittle** in respect of premises known as **Voodoo Lounge, 10 Friars Gate, Warrington.**

Members of the Licensing Sub-Committee have considered carefully all of the written and verbal representations submitted by and on behalf of the applicant and Cheshire Constabulary.

Members are aware of their obligations under the Licensing Act 2003 and have fully considered the guidance issued under Section 182 of the Act. Members have also given careful consideration to the Council's statement of licensing policy.

Having regard to the Objection Notice as submitted by Cheshire Constabulary, members of the Licensing Sub-Committee have resolved to:

Issue a Counter Notice under Section 105(2) of the Act as they considered it necessary for the promotion of the Licensing objective of Crime and Disorder for the following reasons.

Members determined that allowing the premises to remain open for an extra 90 minutes has the potential to exacerbate the crime and disorder currently being experienced within the town centre.

Members also took into account that Mr Keane had himself confirmed that the event would still continue without the extra time applied for being granted.

Members determined that the applicant had not demonstrated that there is a special event to be carried on.

21 day right of appeal notified to all parties.
