What Allows You To Use My Information?

We are required by the following acts of legislation to provide information advice and guidance to specific audiences relating to each act. This is a statutory service the council is bound by

- The Childcare Act 2006
- The Children and Families Act 2016
- The Special Educational Needs and Disability reform 2014
- The Care Act 2014

Who Will My Information Be Shared With?

Families Information Service (FIS) share your information by telephone, face to face, in writing and via the internet on the Family Services Directory website. The online directory is widely available to all professionals and volunteers working with children and easily accessible to young people, children and families hence it is important that we provide up to date, accurate information

Information via the Internet will be displayed on the Family Services Directory website www.mylifewarrington.co.uk and other website(s) that the FIS feed directly into. It may, if appropriate, be shared with and displayed on: -

- other Local Authority Departments and websites
- Government licensed websites

Do I Have To Provide This Information And What Will Happen If I Don't?

The information you provide will be held by the Families Information Service and supplied to the public only if you have given your consent to do so. Your consent will be collected when we undertake the annual check of your information

How Long Will You Keep This Data For And Why? We will retain this information for 12 months from the point of collection or until we undertake the annual check of you information. We are retaining this for the purpose of ensuring that your accurate contact details are maintained as a registered provider of childcare.

How Will My Information Be Stored? Your information will be stored securely within a secure data centre

What Rights Do I Have When It Comes To My Data?

Under the General Data Protection Regulation, you might have more rights about what happens with your data. As different rights apply in different situations each request will be assessed on a case by case basis.

You have the right under the Data Protection Act 1998 (General Data Protection Regulation) to request a copy of your information and to know what it is used for and how it has been shared. This is called the right of subject access.
