



**LICENSING ACT 2003: NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR THE REVIEW OF A PREMISES LICENCE**

**TAKE NOTICE** that an application has been made pursuant to Section 51 of the Licensing Act 2003 for the review of the premises licence in force for:

The grounds for review are:

That the licensing objective of Prevention of Crime and Disorder and Public Safety have not been promoted at the premises in that there have been incidents of violent and aggressive conduct by the individuals associated with the management of the premises and door supervisors employed at the premises amounting to criminality. There have been multiple failures to comply with the "CCTV" condition.

Any interested party or responsible authority wishing to make representations on the application must do so to the Licensing Authority of Warrington Borough Council referred to above. Representations must be in writing and must be received by the Licensing Authority no later than the 31<sup>st</sup> December 2014.

It is an **offence** knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application punishable with a maximum fine of **£5000** on summary conviction.
