TAKE NOTICE that an application has been made pursuant to Section 51 of the Licensing Act 2003 for the review of the premises licence in force for:

The grounds for review are:

That the licensing objective of Prevention of Crime and Disorder and Protection of Children from Harm have not been promoted at the premises in that there have been sales to underage persons and breaches in conditions with regard to CCTV and the Designated Premise Supervisor in respect of the premises.

Any interested party or responsible authority wishing to make representations on the application must do so to the Licensing Authority of Warrington Borough Council referred to above. Representations must be in writing and must be received by the Licensing Authority no later than the 13th day of July 2009.

It is an **offence** knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application punishable with a maximum fine of **£5000** on summary conviction.
