



## LICENSING ACT 2003: NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR THE REVIEW OF A PREMISES LICENCE

**TAKE NOTICE** that an application has been made pursuant to Section 51 of the Licensing Act 2003 for the review of the premises licence in force for:

**PRINCE OF WALES, 1 SCOTLAND ROAD, WARRINGTON,  
CHESHIRE, WA1 2AG**

The grounds for review are:

That the licensing objective of the Prevention of Crime and Disorder has not been promoted at the premises in that there have been unacceptable numbers of violent incidents and anti-social behaviour at the premises.

Any interested party or responsible authority wishing to make representations on the application must do so to the Licensing Authority of Warrington Borough Council referred to above. Representations must be in writing and must be received by the Licensing Authority no later than the 17<sup>th</sup> May 2013.

It is an **offence** knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application punishable with a maximum fine of **£5000** on summary conviction.
