

# LICENSING ACT 2003 NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR THE REVIEW OF A PREMISES LICENCE

Warrington Borough Council as the relevant Licensing Authority, pursuant to sections 3 and 12 of the Licensing Act 2003 hereby **GIVE NOTICE** that it has received an application for review of the premises licence in respect of the premises known as:-

## **Roma Community Store and Off Licence 109-111 Orford Lane, Warrington**

The grounds for review are that the operation of the premises is undermining the licensing objectives, particularly:

- a) The Prevention of Crime and Disorder (selling illicit tobacco products and failing to ensure an effective CCTV system is operational within the premises)
- b) The Protection of Children from harm (numerous breaches of licence conditions, including staff training, Age Verification and Refusals)

The register containing a record of the grounds for review may be inspected by appointment on Monday to Friday from 09:00 to 16:30 (except bank holidays) at the offices of the Licensing Authority at Warrington Borough Council, New Town House, Buttermarket Street, Warrington, WA1 2NH or alternatively it can be viewed on Warrington Borough Council's internet website at:

Any person or responsible authority may make representations in respect of the application which must be provided, in writing, to the Licensing Section, at the above mentioned address. Such representations must be received by the Licensing Section no later than **27<sup>th</sup> December 2018**

It is an **offence** to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with an application punishable with a maximum fine of **£5000** on summary conviction.
