



LICENSING ACT 2003: NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR THE REVIEW OF A PREMISES LICENCE

TAKE NOTICE that an application has been made pursuant to Section 51 of the Licensing Act 2003 for the review of the premises licence in force for **Shenanigans, 116 Bridge Street, Warrington, Cheshire, WA1 2RU.**

The grounds for review are that there are a number of incidents of drunkenness, violence and anti-social behaviour at the premise. Alcohol has been sold to a drunken person and to a person under the age of 18 years. The nature and style of the operation of the premises is undermining the licensing objectives particularly:

- Prevention of Crime & Disorder
- Protection of Children from Harm

The register containing a record of the grounds for review can be inspected by appointment on Monday to Friday from 09:00 to 16:30 (except bank holidays) at the offices of the Licensing Authority at:

Any responsible authority or other person wishing to make representations on the application must do so to the Licensing Authority of Warrington Borough Council referred to above. Representations must be in writing and must be received by the Licensing Authority no later than the **4th July 2014.**

It is an **offence** knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application punishable with a maximum fine of **£5000** on summary conviction.
