



**LICENSING ACT 2003: NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR THE REVIEW OF A PREMISES LICENCE**

**TAKE NOTICE** that an application has been made pursuant to Section 51 of the Licensing Act 2003 for the review of the premises licence in force for:

**The Bells  
Longshaw Street  
Warrington  
WA5 0DE**

The grounds for review are:

That the nature and style of the operation of the premises is undermining the licensing objectives, particularly:

- Prevention of Crime & Disorder – The premises is not adhering to its hours of operation or exercising effective management resulting in violence, drunkenness and anti-social behaviour at the premises.
- Public Safety – The Premises Licence Holder & Designated Premises Supervisor are operating the premises without carrying out appropriate maintenance which is leading to the conditions impacting on public safety.

The register containing a record of the grounds for review can be inspected by appointment on Monday to Friday from 09:00 to 16:30 (except bank holidays) at the offices of the Licensing Authority at:

Any interested party or responsible authority wishing to make representations on the application must do so to the Licensing Authority of Warrington Borough Council referred to above. Representations must be in writing and must be received by the Licensing Authority no later than the **5<sup>th</sup> May 2017**.

It is an **offence** knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application punishable with a maximum fine of **£5000** on summary conviction.
