Subject: Green Belt Crouchley Lane

I am a local resident Lymm and as such I wish to comment as below re the green belt land around this location. I am aware that land has been submitted for consideration between Crouchley Lane and Higher Lane (A56).

- 1- this area of land has no borders and as such I am concerned of encroachment and continued growth- at what point does the village stop growing?
- 2- schools and Dr's are already at capacity in the immediate area in terms of primary provision.
- 3- Crouchley Lane is a narrow country lane and could not accommodate large volumes of vehicles.
- 4- the area borders ancient woodland and conservation area within 250 m and at present there is little light pollution so bats and other animals thrive.
- 5- the proposed field is and contributes towards green space and the purpose of green built land to provide views of open countryside. This area of Lymm is renowned for its openness and green belt status.
- 6- there are other viable sites which have natural defined borders already in that they are surrounded by existing residential settlement. This site is an extension to the size of the village.
- 7- new housing would look at odds with the surrounding housing stock particularly those on the border i.e. Water tower and large open plan properties .

Please protect the village and the rural status of this side of Lymm. Otherwise it just becomes another town built up.
