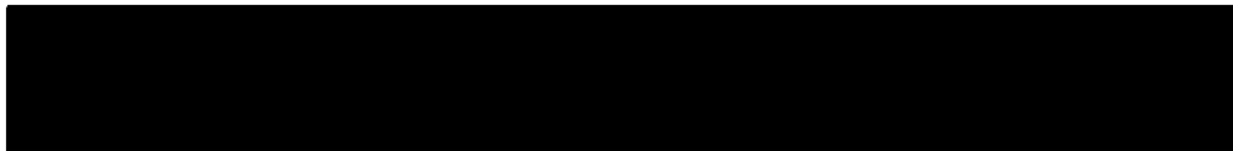






Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing my objections and concerns about Warrington Borough Council's Preferred Development Option (Regulation 18 Consultation July 2017) and Peel Holdings waterside development.



- I am concerned that the development of Peel Port Warrington will increase noise and traffic. At the moment I already experience nuisance noise levels. If this development goes ahead and warehousing is put in situ noise levels will rise dramatically. This will have an adverse effect on the well- being of myself and my family.
- My main concern is the loss of Moore Nature Reserve as it is used by ourselves and Moore Primary School on a regular basis. It will be a loss to businesses in the village such as the Village shop and The Red Lion as the plans would greatly reduce footfall.
- At present there is a distinct boundary between Warrington and Runcorn. However if the councils plans go ahead this will disappear and the towns are in danger of merging thereby urbanising Moore.
