



I am also very concerned about the impact of Port Warrington on Moore Nature Reserve which is important for both wildlife and people in equal measure and must be protected for future generations. Commendably, the Nature reserve was developed in the 1980's by Peel Holdings and is now a flourishing habitat for many diverse species of birds, owls, insects, wildflowers and newts. I have regularly spotted owls and bats around the site as well as many species of birds.
