Having attended the packed meeting last week to view the poorly illustrated map of the proposed site of properties to be built on our greenbelt land, I write to state my strong opposition to the proposal on the following grounds. -

- ① Countryside erosion - impact on wildlife and local peoples well being.
- ② The number of properties proposed - Local areas are prone to flooding. A problem already in our low lying area.
- ③ Traffic - 24,000 houses means at least 48,000+ cars. Local motorway junctions are already gridlocked + at rush hour so are local A. roads. The new road system will not move traffic onto the motorway or through Warrington Bridge Foot.
- ④ Pollution - Asthma + other chest infections already high in our local schools, caused by poor air quality.
- ⑤ Hospitals - How will our already ^{stretched} NHTS cope?
