My father worked all his working life on the land locally, he loved the countryside in the South of Warrington - and spent many hours walking round the area, he loved the rural landscape and all the wildlife round and about.

I am also told there is a plan to widen the old Railway Embankment in Grappenhall + construct a road, thus destroying local habitats, for nesting Birds and destroying years of growth of trees and the shelter and undergrowth the Birds need!

This should not be allowed to happen, there would be loss

of value to all the neighbouring houses through no fault of their own - the disruption in and around the area would be horrendous with all the work that would be needed to build a road.

There is also another idea to build thousands of houses in South Warrington and create a Garden City. We do not need it, once countryside is lost it cannot ever be the same. This area of Warrington doesn't need to become a city.

I know I do not now live in Grappenhall but felt I must speak out before it is too late.
