In the twenty years I have lived in Appleton Thorn, four working farms have closed, and now the largest farm of them all, Friars farm, (Applejacks, Spooky World etc) over 300 acres of prime farmland is earmarked for the same. This is a scandal robbing future generations of a food supply source. Farms of this size should be saved from any development.

If we are to build on the greenbelt, smaller sites should be chosen from various areas around the town.
