**COVID-19 RESPONSE – SACRED HEART PRIMARY SCHOOL – NO STOPPING ON SCHOOL ENTRANCE MARKINGS**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that, with effect from 17<sup>th</sup> September 2020, for a period not exceeding 21 days, the Council will introduce the following restrictions: -

1. To prohibit all Motor Vehicles from stopping on School Entrance Markings between the hours of 8.00am to 5.00pm Monday to Friday at the locations specified in the Schedule to this notice.

The restrictions will be effective as and when indicated by traffic signs on site. This Notice supersedes any contravening orders. The restrictions are required to facilitate COVID-19 response and recovery measures.

**SCHEDULE – NO STOPPING ON SCHOOL ENTRANCE MARKINGS**

**Passageway No. 1045** - From the southern extent of Passageway No. 1045 for a distance of 37.56 metres in a northerly direction.

**Passageway No. 1045** - From a point 37.56 metres north of the southern extent of Passageway No. 1045 for a distance of 37.56 metres in a northerly direction.

**Passageway No. 1045** - From a point 75.12 metres north of the southern extent of Passageway No. 1045 for a distance of 25.56 metres in a northerly direction.
