I object to the Warrington Local Plans, to the release of greenbelt and specifically object to the preferred option of creating a garden city in the South of Warrington.

I object to the land surrounding Weaste Lane being developed on which will be detrimental to the local wildlife (buzzards/kestrels/several species of owls/bats). This is working farm land.

Affordable housing is needed in Warrington which can be done on brown belt areas.

The new housing population will create even more intense traffic congestion and pollution throughout the town. The surrounding roads cannot take the extra amount of traffic that this project will make. Its forever gridlocked now when the ship canal bridges go up to allow passage of ships or there is a problem on the M6 .

Hospitals and doctors surgeries will not be able to cope with the proposed increase in population as it is already under capacity. Providing local health centres will not resolve this.

I object to the proposal of a strategic road running over Weaste Lane and onto the transpennine way which is a much used pathway for cyclists, runners, dog walkers, families of walkers. This will destroy the village status of Thelwall and Grappenhall. You want to make a Garden City of Warrington when it has not even got a decent town centre.
