

Comments: I am deeply concerned about the proposal to build on the greenbelt/fields in Croft. The impact of building on such a scale would be huge to both wildlife and on us as the people of Croft. We have chosen to live in a small village and want to maintain that way of life. We are a small close community - this proposed development would cause us to lose this simply by the number of proposed dwellings. The increase in the traffic on our roads (already a problem on the small narrow roads we have passing through the village) would escalate exponentially. The risk to pedestrians would markedly increase, including some of our most vulnerable village residents - our children. Many roads have no paths for pedestrians currently as it is, increasing the number and frequency of traffic on these could/would have a dangerous outcome. The roads within the housing scheme would also become busier as they would link with the new development road which currently we feel are safe to let our children ride their bikes on and cross over on their own. That would end as the risk became too high. All this doesn't reflect the massive noise levels involved in building, the heavy vehicles traversing already narrow and over-busy roads, the disruption to existing services for our current residents while this building is undertaken. Nor does it take into account the impact on our schools, childcare facilities and GP provision. Please refuse this planning application. Our way of life is important to us and we

want to preserve it for us and our children.
