THE BOROUGH OF WARRINGTON (COVID-19 RESPONSE) (LONDON ROAD, STOCKTON HEATH) (DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACE) TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, in not less than 7 days from the date of this Notice, the Council intends to make an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of which will be to introduce the following restrictions: -

1. Revoke The Borough of Warrington (Covid-19 Response) (London Road, Stockton Heath) (Suspension of Limited Waiting Bay) Temporary Order 2020 in its entirety.
2. Temporarily suspend the Order specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Notice to the extent as detailed in Column 2 of the said Schedule.
3. The Borough of Warrington (Traffic Management) (Civil Enforcement) Consolidation Order 2018 is amended by the addition to Schedule 79 of a Disabled Persons Parking Place as detailed in Schedule 2 to this Notice.

The order will be effective from 30th November 2020 for a maximum period of 18 months and will be effective as and when indicated by traffic signs on site. This Order supersedes any contravening orders. The restrictions are required to facilitate COVID-19 response and recovery measures.

SCHEDULE 1 – SUSPENSION

Column 1 Areas of Highway Designated as Disabled Persons' Parking Places. Each Area described below in this column being an area forming part of the carriageway of a specific highway, as a designated Disabled Persons' Parking Place	Column 2 Special Manner of Standing of Vehicle in Parking Place
All that part of the east side of London Road which is bounded on the east side by so much of the edge of the carriageway of that highway as extends from the projected building line between property numbers 29 and 31 London Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 6.6 metres, all measured along the said road and which has a width throughout of 2.7 metres.	Parallel to the kerb
