Although some areas of the town have excellent bus services, e.g. Poplars, Bewsey and Dallam, people who live in the surrounding areas do not have the same quality of bus service e.g. more frequent, quicker journeys to town, and better connections with the shopping and retail outlets outside Winwick, Penketh and the Westbrook area. This means that townspeople who do not own cars, are prevented from purchasing the more bulky or heavy quantities of certain goods, furniture, horticultural and other items of gardening and leisure use, are deprived of access to them. In my opinion this means they are at quite a lot of disadvantage in reaching a good quality of such goods with extra delivery charges adding to their household budgetary costs. Thought should be given also to estates where people do not have a bus stop or bus shelter within an easily reach of their homes, especially the elderly and disabled. For these areas, perhaps a circular bus scheme, where people could wave down a bus so they could get on it where ever they are.
