10.2.10, The current industrial area is not in the village of Appleton Thorn. People wishing to work there who don't own cars have to walk there along roads with no pavements. 10.2.17, The first phase is already started but there is no additional school provision, amenities, or additional infrastructure being built to accommodate this. We already suffer from low water pressure in Appleton Thorn, what is being done to mitigate this? With being so near the motorways Appleton Thorn will see an increase in traffic, and with it a decrease in the air quality. How many houses are in phase 1 and how many houses need to be built before amenities, including better bus services, are introduced? If 30% of the houses are to be for lower income families public transport will be essential. The local primary and secondary school are already over subscribed and any additional housing will add to that burden. Having a contribution to additional secondary school places is not good enough. Teaching in schools where there are over 30 kids in a class, and not enough chairs for them is not acceptable. Doctors surgeries are already not managing with the demand, so additional provision for doctors and dentists is required.

10.3.17 Many locals work in the North of the town, and expanding means that you are making commuting times longer. What will be done about the additional car pollution that increasing housing will cause? We do not want a repeat of the Chapelford Urban Village where residents had to wait years for a bus route into town.

There should be a lower number of houses being built. Regenerate the brownfield sites in Warrington first, leave the green fields for everyone to enjoy. When an estate of more than 50 houses is built the council should have a checklist to make sure that this is appropriate, making decisions about where the children will go to school both primary (walking distance) and secondary, where people will catch a bus to town, where the local shops are, and how people will get to the doctor and dentist. If the transport infrastructure is not in place, then people will not be able to live a full life, then becoming a burden on the NHS. Appleton Thorn is currently a village, but with the huge increase in housing the identity of the village will go, and with the loss of the green open space, will be unrecognisable. It will have lost its character, heritage, and nature surroundings.
