This is our objection to the proposed plan.

Large areas of green belt land will be lost. 4200 houses will be built on what is now Green belt. These houses will not be affordable for people working in the nearby logistics sites. This would mean they will be bought by out-of-town commuters which means yet more traffic to add to the already congested roads. Warrington comes to a stand still every time there is a problem on the M6. The promised employment is in logistics and distribution which is increasingly becoming automated therefore will not generate anymore jobs. These businesses require a huge number of vehicles which will cut through the narrow roads that surround the town. Warrington is recognised as one of the most polluted towns, increased traffic will add to what is already a serious issue.
