Dear Sir,

I write to raise a number of objections to the proposed local plan for Warrington. Not alone is the scale of the plan unnecessary but the substantial loss of green belt land, and green areas for this and future generations to enjoy, is both environmentally unfriendly and again unnecessary in view of the brownfield sites available.

My principal objections are as follows:

- The scale of building in Appleton and Lymm is both unnecessary (this much housing is based on over optimistic growth forecasts) and wholly unsupported by growth in infrastructure, especially transport.
- Where development is essential it should first take place on available brownfield sites and not destroy green belt unnecessarily.
- Development of logistics sites will bring questionable benefits in number of jobs but will bring substantial environmental issues especially in term of pollution from the huge increase in traffic.

A plan of this scale is not necessary - please reconsider.
