Objections to Local Plan:

I feel that the whole plan looks very unfair in relation to the proportion of houses, in that the largest affected area is Appleton/Appleton Thorn which is a large Green Belt area stated in the plan as being 'generally weaker'. There is no explanation to what this means. The area currently provides green spaces for farming, wildlife and a place for people to enjoy.

We chose to live in the Country and enjoy Country life - this will not be replaced with the proposed 'Country park' which will not encourage the wildlife the same as the existing natural spaces now.

Appleton Thorn is a thriving village with a Church, Village Hall with village activities and village pub, all of which contributes to the wellbeing of living in a small village. We have not chosen to live in a 'Garden Suburb' with many houses, with many people with much more noise and light pollution!

We understand that there needs to be a strategic plan for future employment and housing in order to benefit the whole area, but this needs to consider everybody and the wider impact, as once the countryside has gone it can not be recovered and a 'green space amongst housing' will never be like an open green field.

The distribution of housing needs to be re-considered in South Warrington and spread more evenly across other parts of the whole area.
