Please reconsider your plans. We do not believe they are sound.

We need to be more green - environmental catastrophe looming. This plan increases congestion and pollution, removes green belt (reducing production of oxygen, drainage, habitat for wildlife - essential for balance of ecosystem).

There are alternative brown sites that can be used and there is not evidence for this amount of housing to be required. (eg old school within Grappenhall village, the old Beers site by the ship canal).

Lose the character of the area - on the edge of countryside - villages - do not want to live in urban mass!

Road system already at capacity - cannot take further increases of traffic. We need to be cutting back on traffic and improving public transport to reduce emissions.

Green belt was created to prevent planning such as this. There are no extreme circumstances to justify using green belt and it would be environmentally unsound and morally wrong for the future.

Please leave green belt alone.
