It is with astonishment that the Warrington Borough Council are proposing the recent 'LOCAL PLAN' for the future development of the Warrington area and specifically Warrington South.

The proposals are ridiculous as they are allowing 5,000 dwellings(Garden Suburb) + 116 Hectares(Employment) + 430 dwellings in Lymm without any itemised infrastructure mentioned. These plots are 'GREEN BELT PLOTS' but the 'plan' does not show any 'BROWN FIELD PLOTS' to be used.

A lot of the roadways in and around Warrington South are not suitable for the HUGE HGV's using them - let alone the massify influx of extra private cars onto these already crowded roads. There is also no indication of additional services, such as 'clinics' or doctors surgeries or extra schools to cope with the increase in population.

I hope the council will take on board these comments & reconsider this plan.
