Dear Sir/Madam

I wrote in September 2017 objecting to the Local Plan Preferred Development Option and understand the latest version is proposing in excess of 5000 new homes to be built on the Green Belt in South Warrington.

I have lived in [REDACTED] years with my family and have two daughters who also live in the area. Whilst I appreciate the need for more housing I have serious concerns about your proposals and the impact they will have on the environment as well as local residents. Traffic congestion has been a major problem for many years and at times Warrington centre is virtually a no go area as far as traffic is concerned. The new Mersey Crossing has only added to these problems. Stockton Heath suffers from major congestion at peak times and the problem is worsened whenever an incident occurs on the M6, causing further traffic to use the A49 as an alternative. Schools, medical centres and other local facilities are already under severe strain and I believe the proposals will put further strain on them.

The latest proposals seem still to be suggesting the excessive use of green belt sites whilst alternative brownfield sites are being ignored.

For these reasons I wish to register my ongoing disapproval and ask you to reconsider your proposals.
