I believe the Draft Local Plan is unsound.

The proposed growth in both housing and employment is excessive for the town's needs.

Inadequate transport mitigation, increased air pollution not adequately provided for in this plan.

This plan gives no details of when, where, or if Warrington will have a new hospital. Warrington hospital is already struggling with the towns existing population. The proposed population growth could not be adequately provided for with the existing facilities.

The proposed allocation of land at Peel Hall is unsustainable, poor air quality, lack of infrastructure, lack of public transport, lack of timely education facilities.

There are no proposals in the plan to tackle the poor air quality in the M62/A49 area.

The proposals for extensive low paid employment and high cost housing on the south side of Warrington does not equate. The proposals would see extensive increase in commuting both in and out of Warrington. Those seeking employment would not be able to afford the proposed high cost housing. Those purchasing the high cost housing would commute to high paid employment in Manchester/Liverpool/Chester.
