At PDO stage 4.5k people objected and yet none of their comments were taken on board for this plan. None of the plan shows any exceptional circumstances for the loss of greenbelt. There are still sufficient brownfield sites for any distribution centres and omega still has empty sites. Fiddlers Ferry power station will provide plenty of capacity for such sites and housing. The amount of housing proposed has been inflated enormously and it goes ahead will destroy all of the villages in south warrington. It would also increase congestion in an area that already has terrible congestion when there is a problem on the motorway. It will also along with any distribution centres increase pollution in an area highlighted by the WHO as having dangerous levels of pollution. All building would destroy wildlife habitats at a time when we require the greenbelt for health as we exercise there which improves mental health.
