## THE BOROUGH OF WARRINGTON (COVID-19 RESPONSE) (LONDON ROAD, STOCKTON HEATH) (DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACE) TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

WHEREAS the Warrington Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") is satisfied that the said road should be restricted to facilitate COVID-19 response and recovery measures that will affect the highway:

**NOW, THEREFORE,** the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:

- The Borough of Warrington (Covid-19 Response) (London Road, Stockton Heath) (Suspension of Limited Waiting Bay) Temporary Order 2020 is revoked in its entirety.
- 2. The Order specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Order is temporarily suspended to the extent as detailed in Column 2 of the said Schedule.
- 3. The Borough of Warrington (Traffic Management) (Civil Enforcement) Consolidation Order 2018 is hereby amended by the addition to Schedule 79 of a Disabled Persons Parking Place as detailed in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 4. This Order shall cease to have effect 18 months from the date of operation and supersedes any contravening orders.
- 5. This Order shall come into operation on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of November 2020 and may be cited as "The Borough of Warrington (Covid-19 Response) (London Road, Stockton Heath) (Disabled Persons Parking Place) Temporary Order 2020".
