

THE BOROUGH OF WARRINGTON (COVID-19 RESPONSE) (BANK STREET/ACADEMY WAY)
(PROHIBITION OF ALL VEHICLES) TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

WHEREAS the Warrington Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) is satisfied that the said roads should be restricted for works to be carried out and to facilitate COVID-19 response and recovery measures that will affect the highway:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:

1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle including ridden pedal cycles and horse-drawn vehicles to be in the lengths of road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Notice to the extent specified in Column 2 of the said Schedule.
2. This Order shall cease to have effect 18 months from the date of operation and supersedes any contravening orders.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 3rd day of August 2020 and may be cited as “The Borough of Warrington (Covid-19 Response) (Bank Street/Academy Way) (Prohibition of All Vehicles) Temporary Order 2020”.


