

THE BOROUGH OF WARRINGTON (COVID-19 RESPONSE) (VARIOUS PROHIBITIONS, RESTRICTIONS AND SUSPENSIONS IN LYMM VILLAGE) TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

WHEREAS the Warrington Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) is satisfied that the said roads should be restricted to facilitate COVID-19 response and recovery measures that will affect the highway:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:

1. The Order specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Order is temporarily suspended to the extent as detailed in Column 2 of the said Schedule.
2. No person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to wait at any time, in the roads specified in Column 1 of Schedule 2 to this Order to the extent specified in Column 2 of the said Schedule.
3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle including ridden pedal cycles and horse-drawn vehicles to enter the length of road specified in Column 1 of Schedule 3 to this Notice to the extent specified in Column 2 of the said Schedule.
4. This Order shall cease to have effect 18 months from the date of operation and supersedes any contravening orders.
5. This Order shall come into operation on the 20th day of August 2020 and may be cited as “The Borough of Warrington (Covid-19 Response) (Various Prohibitions, Restrictions and Suspensions in Lymm Village) Temporary Order 2020”.
