I am writing to express my objection to the proposed Development plans across Warrington and TPT bypass.

As a resident in Stockton Heath I feel that I will be directly impacted by these plans if they go ahead and strongly appose them. One of my main concerns is the increased traffic that these plans would bring to the road network in Warrington, a network which is already clogged and traffic is getting worse and worse across the town. This does not seem to have been considered by the plan at all. The proposed plans would directly impact my quality of life, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] The current traffic situation is very worrying so the thought of a significant number of additional cars on the roads in the area, is very concerning.

As well as this, the plans to use greenbelt land is something that I am very much against, I moved to this area of Warrington because of the lovely green spaces and use them regularly with my family, I enjoy the wildlife in these areas and would be very upset to see these effected. It would change the whole nature of the area for myself and my family and take away a lot of leisure activities we like in the area. In particular the plans for the TPT and green spaces used for the proposed garden city suburb.

This area of Warrington has a real charm and character, based on Warrington's history, the bridges and the canals are a special part of the town. To have them widened, changed or modernised would take away the character from the area. It would be more beneficial to have them maintained as they are so they look more attractive than their current state of disrepair.

The increase in residents would likely come from commuter areas such as Manchester and Liverpool as Warrington residents do not need this large quantity of additional houses. This would mean an addition number of commuters on the roads and increased demand on road services which are already very stretched. I would much prefer to see the current infrastructure improved rather than growing the Town into a City and adding new suburbs. I like living in a Town, I chose to live in a Town rather than a City and do not want Warrington to become a city. [REDACTED]
