THE BOROUGH OF WARRINGTON (COVID-19 RESPONSE) (WALTON HALL & APPLETON RESERVOIR)
(24 HOUR CLEARWAY) TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, in not less than 7 days from the date of this Notice, the Council intends to make an Order under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of which will be to introduce a 24 Hour Clearway, prohibiting Motor Vehicles from stopping or remaining at rest at any time, on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice to the extent as detailed in the said Schedule. The order will be effective from 26th March 2021 for a maximum period of 18 months and will be effective as and when indicated by traffic signs on site. This Order supersedes any contravening orders. The restrictions are required as part of the proposed relaxation in lockdown entering the summer months to address potential large numbers of visitors in relation to COVID-19 pandemic response and recovery measures.

SCHEDULE

Firs Lane	Entire length.
Hough's Lane	Entire length.
Park Lane	Entire length.
Walton Lea Road	Entire length.
Warrington Road	From its junction with Old Chester Road in a southerly direction to a point approximately 145 metres south east of its junction with Park Lane.
Whitefield Road	From its junction with Walton Lea Road to its junction with Old Hall Close.
