ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(2)
COVID-19 RESPONSE – WALTON HALL & APPLETON RESERVOIR - 24 HOUR CLEARWAY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, with effect from 5th March 2021, for a period not exceeding 21 days, the Council will introduce a 24 Hour Clearway, prohibiting Motor Vehicles from stopping or remaining at rest at any time, on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice to the extent as detailed in the said Schedule.

The restrictions will be effective as and when indicated by traffic signs on site. This Notice supersedes any contravening orders. The restrictions are required as part of the proposed relaxation in lockdown entering the summer months to address potential large numbers of visitors in relation to COVID-19 pandemic response and recovery measures.

SCHEDULE

Firs Lane	Entire length.
Hough's Lane	Entire length.
Park Lane	Entire length.
Walton Lea Road	Entire length.
Warrington Road	From its junction with Old Chester Road in a southerly direction to a point approximately 145 metres south east of its junction with Park Lane.
Whitefield Road	From its junction with Walton Lea Road to its junction with Old Hall Close.
