

THE BOROUGH OF WARRINGTON (COVID-19 RESPONSE) (WALTON HALL & APPLETON RESERVOIR)
(24 HOUR CLEARWAY) TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

WHEREAS the Warrington Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) is satisfied that the said roads should be restricted to facilitate COVID-19 response and recovery measures that will affect the highway:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:

1. No person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to stop or remain at rest at any time on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order to the extent as detailed in the said Schedule.
2. This Order shall cease to have effect 18 months from the date of operation and supersedes any contravening orders.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 26th day of March 2021 and may be cited as “The Borough of Warrington (Covid-19 Response) (Walton Hall & Appleton Reservoir) (24 Hour Clearway) Temporary Order 2021”.

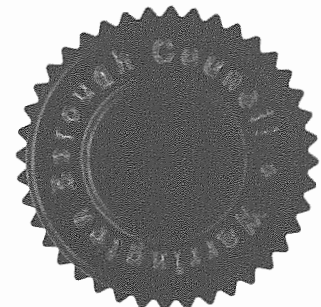
SCHEDULE

Firs Lane	Entire length.
Hough’s Lane	Entire length.
Park Lane	Entire length.
Walton Lea Road	Entire length.
Warrington Road	From its junction with Old Chester Road in a southerly direction to a point approximately 145 metres south east of its junction with Park Lane.
Whitefield Road	From its junction with Walton Lea Road to its junction with Old Hall Close.
