Re Matter 6f - Statement on East/ West Connectivity

Dear Ladies & Government EIP Inspectors,

Following making previous statements at Matter 1, 6b, and 6f Hearings, I am making a response as a member of the S Warrington RSWF community group especially Appleton Thorn residents who would be heavily impacted by unsound and unwelcome transportation plans as part of SEWEA and SEWUE proposals if the new proposed version of the Local Plan under discussion is accepted and delivered following the recent EIP process.

In particular local residents are most concerned about the possibility of a tortuous new road link in our area which would essentially be a main distribution road allowing HGV traffic to use an alternative route connecting the area btw Appleton Thorn and Stretton villages as a way to access the local M56 and M6 motorway networks. if these proposals are delivered it would have a dreadful impact on both villages creating excessive and constant gaseous/particulate, noise, light, and vibratory pollution thereby changing for the worst the character of our most valued peaceful local residential area.

In short, our S Warrington community especially Appleton Thorn residents would appreciate if Warrington LPI EIP Government Inspectors would support the necessary steps to safeguard our local community's rural character and in particular seek to help impose the essential weight restrictions that exclude HGV access from the SEWEA to/from existing/proposed residential areas.
