
Essential Roadworks

A49 London Road Structural Maintenance Phase 1 Starting 23 January 2023 for up to 6 Weeks



Residents, Businesses and Motorists are advised that major road works to resurface A49 LONDON ROAD, Appleton, between Lyon's Lane/Quarry Lane and Fairways are programmed to commence on 23 January 2023 and will take up to 6 weeks to complete.

The road will be closed between 7:00pm and 1:00am to undertake the works safely.

All roads will be fully open to traffic outside these times.

The signed diversion route will be via Longwood Road, Broom Avenue and Lyon's Lane.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times during the works.

Vehicular access will be under the control of the contractor as directed on site.

Vehicles parked on the road, footway or verge obstructing the works may be removed.

Information on bus services will be posted at stops prior to the commencement of the works.
